ORDER

Having heard Mr. Harish Salve, learned senior counsel
appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Mukul Rohtagi, learned
senior counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent, we are of the

any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter. We request the High Court to consider the desirability of disposing of the Writ Petition filed by the respondent as expeditiously as possible and preferably within six weeks from the date of the communication of this order.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly.
