This matter was taken up at the Supreme Court Lok Adalat with the consent and agreement through their counsel. The following settlement is recorded :

The petitioner Smriti Dewan is the wife and respondent Ajay Kumar Dewan, her father-in-law. Dr. Siddharth Dewan, husband of the petitioner is not a party in this transfer petition.

Petitioner, her husband, her father-in-law alongwith other family members started negotiations for settlement with the assistance of two learned advocate mediators. There are following litigations pending between the parties:

Four cases by the husband namely Criminal Complaint Case under Sections 416/419/500 IPC, HMA Case No.56/2009, Guardianship Case No.10/2008 and Divorce Petition No.96/2009;

Two cases by her father-in-law namely Civil Suit No.484/2008 and Criminal Complaint Case No.58/2009;

One case by the petitioner under Domestic Violence Act No.M46/2007; and

One case by the child Ashima through her mother for maintenance under Section 125 CrPC bearing No.80/2007;

The parties have settled all the pending disputes in terms of paras 7a) to 7(o) of the 'Settlement Agreement' annexed hereto as Annexure-1. In terms of it, the petitioner, the respondent, the petitioner's husband have agreed to withdraw the respective cases filed by them. The petitioner and her husband have also agreed to file a petition under Section 28 of the Special Marriage Act for divorce by mutual consent. The husband and father-in-law have agreed to return certain articles and disclose the PPF account number. Parties agree to give effect to all the terms diligently to put an end to the various litigations. Both the parties and Dr. Siddharth Dewan affirm and

declare that they have not filed or initiated any other civil or criminal case other than what has been disclosed in the 'Settlement Agreement'.

In terms of the 'Settlement Agreement', this transfer petition is disposed of.
