O R D E R

1. Learned counsel appearing for the parties submit that the matter can be referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre to explore the possibility of arriving at an amicable settlement.
2. The parties are directed to appear before the Supreme Court Mediation Centre virtually on the first hearing which is fixed on 18.03.2026 at 11:00 am without waiting for any further notice. In case the nominated learned mediator requires the physical presence of the parties then the parties may appear physically for which the respondent-husband will have to pay ₹ 25000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) per hearing for travel expenses to the petitioner-wife to attend and participate in the mediation.
3. List the matter after the mediation report is received.
4. The interim orders dated 15.10.2025 and 20.02.2026 shall continue to operate till the next date of hearing.
