T.P.(C) No.3560 of 2025:-

1. Heard learned counsel on both sides. The submissions reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.
2. In such circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Center on 20.04.2026 at 11.00 a.m. The Coordinator shall appoint a Mediator to enable the parties to make an effort to settle the matter amicably.
3. Initially, the parties are permitted to appear virtually and thereafter, the parties shall appear as per the directions of the Mediator.
4. List the matter along with Mediation Report on 22.07.2026.
5. Interim order granted earlier to continue until the next date of listing.
6. If the learned Mediator requires the physical presence of the petitioner/wife, then the travel, lodging and boarding expenses of her shall be borne by the respondent/husband.

T.P. (Crl.) No.117 of 2026:-

1. Heard learned counsel on both sides. The submissions reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.

2. In such circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Center on 20.04.2026 at 11.00 a.m. The Coordinator shall appoint a Mediator to enable the parties to make an effort to settle the matter amicably.

3. Initially, the parties are permitted to appear virtually and thereafter, the parties shall appear as per the directions of the Mediator.
