District- Raipur, for the offences punishable under Sections 317(2), 317(4), 317(5) and 111 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

We have been informed that the charge sheet has been filed. It is also submitted that bail has been granted to the similarly placed accused persons by this Court vide order dated 18.12.2025 in *Vikas Madhwani v. State of Chhattisgarh*, Criminal Appeal No.5615/2025 and connected matters.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, we are inclined to grant bail to the appellants.

Accordingly, the impugned orders are set aside and the appellants are granted bail on the terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court.

However, we make it clear that the appellants shall continue to cooperate with

the further investigation, which, according to the learned counsel appearing for the State is still continuing.

The appeals stand allowed, accordingly.
