O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.

3. We find that the main impugned judgment of the High Court dated 23.08.2022 already stands set aside by this Court vide a reported judgment in Horrnal v. State of Haryana, 2024 SCC OnLine SC 2990.
4. Consequently, the appellants are also held entitled to the same amount of compensation as has been awarded to the other land owners vide the above-cited judgment, except that the appellants shall not be entitled to any interest for the period of delay in filing these appeals. Ordered accordingly.
5. The appeals stand allowed to the extent indicated above.
