ORDER

The present transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of the petition filed for restitution of conjugal rights by the respondent-husband bearing HMA No. 659 of 2022, titled as "*Shri Manoj Kumar Vs. Smt. Shobha*"(subject-case), pending in the Family Court, South East, Saket Court, Delhi to the Family Court, Bihar Sharif, Nalanda, Bihar.

Since Mr. Yashraj Singh Deora, learned Advocate-on-Record, who had earlier filed the present petition has been designated as Senior Advocate, Ms. Nidhi, learned Advocate-on-Record, appears for the petitioner-wife.
