By filing this petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 the petitioner has prayed to transfer Matrimonial Case No. 1764 of 2010 titled as Shri Mitra Kumar Patel Vs. Smt. Sharmishtha Patel pending before the Family Court at Bangalore to District Court/Family Court at Seoni, Madhya Pradesh.

This Court has heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent who has appeared in-person.

This Court has also taken into consideration the averments made by the respondent in his affidavit in reply. For the reasons mentioned in grounds Nos. 18(B) to 18(H) of petition, this Court is of the opinion that sufficient cause is made out by the petitioner for grant of relief claimed in the petition.
