This petition is directed against the order of the Delhi High Court, which declined to interfere with the order passed by the Principal Bench of the Central Administrative Tribunal, dismissing the original application filed by the petitioner for quashing the order of his transfer from Delhi to Diu, Dadra and Nagar Haveli.

We have heard Shri Kailash Vasdev, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner.            In our view, the order under challenge does not suffer from any infirmity            warranting

interference under Article 136 of the Constitution.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, on the oral request made by the learned senior counsel we deem it proper to extend the time fixed by the High Court for joining of the petitioner is extended to April 30, 2011.

It is needless to say that if the petitioner fails to comply with the order of transfer by April 30, 2011, the department shall be

free to take appropriate action against him in accordance with  
law.
