O R D E RSLP(C) No. 405/2019

Despite last opportunity having been granted, respondent Nos.1 to 3 have not filed counter affidavit, as such, further opportunity to file counter affidavit stands declined.

SLP(C) No. 1755/2019

Four weeks' time is granted to respondent Nos.1, 2, 3, 4 and 9 for filing counter affidavit.

Service is complete on respondent Nos.5, 6 and 8 but none has entered appearance.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner to take fresh steps for effecting service on respondent No.7 within two weeks. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner requested to serve the said respondent through District Judge. Permission granted. Notice be issued through District Judge in terms of Order LIII Rule 3, Supreme Court Rules, 2013.

SLP(C) No. 2981-2982/2019

Service is complete on respondent Nos.1, 4, 6 and 7. Ld. Advocate, Mr.Seshatalpa Sai Bandaru, appearing on behalf of Mr.Nishant R. Katneshwarkar, Advocate-on-record appears for the said respondents. He seeks time to file vakalatnama and counter affidavit. Be filed within four weeks.

Remaining respondents have been served but none has entered appearance.

SLP(C) No. 5935/2019

None appeared for respondent No.1 when called. The record shows that vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed on 15.5.2019, however, counter affidavit has not been filed till today. There is neither written application for extension of time to file pleadings in terms of Order V Rule 1(22), Supreme Court Rules, 2013 nor is there oral request to that effect. It appears that the respondent is not interested in filing counter affidavit and, therefore, opportunity to file counter affidavit stands declined.

Service is complete on respondent No.3. Ld. Advocate, Mr.Seshatalpa Sai Bandaru, appearing on behalf of Mr.Nishant R. Katneshwarkar, Advocate-on-record appears for respondent No.3. He seeks time to file vakalatnama and counter affidavit. Be filed within four weeks.

Service is complete on respondent Nos.2, 4 and 5 but none has entered appearance.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner in SLP(C) No. 405/2019 submits that this matter may be listed before the Hon'ble Court on the ground that the other matters are not tagged with this matter.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner in SLP(C)No.1755/2019 also makes request to list the matter before the Hon'ble Court as there is urgency and according to him this matter would become infructuous if not listed immediately before the Hon'ble Court.
