**OFFICE REPORT**

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 13.7.2015 when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:

"Learned counsel for the petitioner is ready with the fixed deposit receipt(FDR) for an amount of Rs. 5 lakhs payable at Punjab National Bank pursuant to an settlement by the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh dated 11.11.2014. He shall deposit the same with the Registry of this Court to the credit of the special leave petition.

The petitioner undertakes to make the deposit of the balance Rs. 12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve lakhs only), as agreed upon in the mediation proceedings. As and when the petitioner deposits the said amount with the Bank, such FDR shall also be deposited with the Registry of this Court.

This matter is adjourned."

It is submitted that in compliance of this Court's Order quoted above, Counsel for the Petitioner has on 15.07.2015 produced a Fixed Deposit Receipt dated 16.04.2015 for an amount of Rs. 5 lakhs in favour of Aditi Sharma-minor under the guardianship of the petitioner herein. Thereafter, the Petitioner-in-Person had deposited Fixed Deposit Receipts in the sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- and 3,50,000/- in favour of Aditi Sharma-minor under the guardianship of the petitioner on 06.11.2016 and 12.07.2016 respectively and are kept in the safe custody of Cash and Accounts Branch.

It is further submitted that the matter above mentioned

was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 20.11.2015, when the Court was pleased to pass the following Order:

**"List the matter in the month of August, 2016."**

It is submitted that the instant matter is an after notice matter.

It is further submitted that the sole Respondent/State of Punjab is represented through Mr. Devendra Singh, Advocate. Counter Affidavit has also been filed and included in the Special Leave Petition Paper Books.

It is lastly submitted that Mr. Ritesh Khatri, Advocate had already filed an application for impleadment of the applicants (1) Krishan Kumar (2) Deepak Sharma and (3) Aditi Sharma (Minor) through legal guardian Krishan Kumar as respondents.

Service of show cause notice is complete.

The matter alongwith application above-mentioned is listed before the Hon'ble Court with this office report.
