O R D E R

SLP(Cr1.) No.12902/2022

1. Application (I.A. No.38842/2023) for deletion of the names of respondents no.3 to 5 is allowed.
2. Cause title be amended accordingly.
3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we do not find any error of law and facts in the impugned order dated 29.10.2022 passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh.
4. The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
5. It goes without saying that the petitioner is at liberty to raise his respective contention before the Trial Court at an appropriate stage. However, the interim bail granted on 06.01.2023 is made absolute. Consequently, the petitioner shall remain on bail during the pendency of trial.
