O R D E R

SLP(C) Nos.14863-14864/2016

From the counter affidavit filed on behalf of Respondent Nos.1 to 4, it is not clear as to whether the lands of the petitioners are similarly situated as those covered by C.A. No.1077/2015.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents seeks three weeks' time to get instruction.

It is made clear that in case specific instruction are not furnished by filing an additional affidavit, within the time granted, mentioning therein the difference, if any, the Court will be constrained to have a decision that the lands are similarly situated and will pass orders accordingly.

SLP(C) No. 14905/2016

The main contention of the petitioners is that their lands are similarly situated as those covered by C.A. No.1077/2015.

The respondents are directed to file an affidavit, within three weeks, as to whether the submission is correct or not. If it is not correct, the extent of difference shall also be indicated in the affidavit.

It is made clear that in case the required affidavit, mentioning therein the difference, if any, is not filed within the time granted the Court will be constrained to have a decision that the lands are similarly situated and will pass orders accordingly.
