O R D E R

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the last 22 years, the parties have been living separately.

Issue notice. Mr. Farrukh Rasheed, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the sole respondent.

The learned counsel for the parties have submitted that an attempt can be made for settlement of the disputes amicably between the parties if the matter is referred to Mediation.

Accordingly, we refer the matter to Supreme Court Mediation Centre, New Delhi to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement of the dispute between the parties, who would appear

before the said Mediation Centre on 04.07.2016 at 11.00 A.M.

The Incharge, Supreme Mediation Centre, after making an endeavour for amicable resolution of the disputes, shall submit a report to this Court within a fortnight thereafter.

The petitioner shall pay the arrears to the respondent-wife within two weeks and shall continue to pay the maintenance.
