O R D E R

Delay condoned.

Issue notice.

Our attention has been invited to the earlier order passed by this Court on 22.11.2019. We pass similar directions and direct as under:

a) Delay condoned.

Subject to the petitioner-State depositing a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only), to the account of this petition in the Registry of this Court within

four weeks from today, let notice be issued to the respondents, returnable on 16.12.2020.

Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.

- b) If the amount is not deposited within the stipulated time, the special leave petitions shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Court.
- c) Upon deposit, the amount shall be invested in a fixed deposit receipt with a nationalized bank initially for a period of 90 days with auto renewal facility.

Let this matter be listed along with all connected matters on 16.12.2020.

In the meantime, the respondents are at liberty to file reply within four weeks. Rejoinder, if any, be filed within a week thereafter.
