O R D E R

S.L.P. (C) No.8459 of 2011

Issue notice, returnable one week after the summer  
vacation.

Since the respondent Nos.1 and 3 are duly represented  
on caveat, service of notice on the said respondents is  
dispensed with.        Let the State of Kerala be served, not only  
in the usual course, but also through the learned Standing  
Counsel for the State of Kerala.

S.L.P. (C) No.9498 of 2011

As far as S.L.P. (C) No.9498 of 2011 is concerned,  
let notice be served on the respondent No.2 only, since the  
others are duly represented.        Service of notice on the  
respondent Nos.1, 3 and 4 is dispensed with.        Let notice be

served on the State of Kerala, both in the usual course and also by way of Dasti service.

The respondents will be entitled to file their respective counter affidavits to the special leave petition within three weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, may be filed by 5th July, 2011.

Let this matter be listed for further consideration on 14th July, 2011.

Till 22nd July, 2011 or until further orders, whichever is earlier, there will be stay of operation of the impugned order of the High Court. This interim order is passed upon the understanding that no equity will be claimed by the private respondents.
