Counsel for the petitioner has cured the defects despite the Registry's letter dated 02.12.2014.

SLP(C) NO: 11777/2014:-

It is submitted that counsel for the petitioner has on 01.12.2014 filed application for substituted service but same is defective for the reason that he mentioned the tile of application substitution instead of substituted service and also
