OFFICE REPORT

It is submitted that Ms. Usha Nandini V., Advocate has filed Special Leave Petition on 08.08.2016 against the Judgment and Order dated 06.10.2015 of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh in RFA Nos. 462, 1359, 1656, 2142, 2143 and 5414 of 2013 alongwith application for permission to file Special Leave Petition and exemption from filing Official Translation of Anenxure.

It is further submitted that Counsel for petitioner has also filed an application for substitution to bring on record the Lrs of deceased petitioner no. 1 namely Rati Ram in SLP (C) No. CC No. 19037/2016 @ RFA No. 2142/2013 which is barred by time by 1218 days and Counsel has also filed an application for condonation of delay in filing substitution application.

It is further submitted that Counsel for the petitioner has filed two applications for condonation of delay in filing the SLP and refiling the SLP (i) there is a delay of 217 days in filing the SLP (ii) a delay of 25 days in refiling the SLP. There is a total delay of 242 days in filing and refiling the SLP.

It is further submitted that the instant matter is tagged with SLP (C) CC Nos. 18893-18897 of 2016 Entitled Ram Kishan & Ors. Etc Versus state Of Haryana And Ors Etc as both are arising out of common order.

The matter is, therefore, listed before the Hon'ble Court with this office report.
