OFFICE REPORT

The Writ Petition alongwith applications above-mentioned except I.A. Nos. 6 and 7 was listed before the Hon'ble Court alongwith connected matters on 24.02.2016, when the Court was pleased to inter-alia pass the following order:-

“Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are inclined to continue the order of stay as far as the continuance of the *Shiksha Mitras* are concerned. The stay order shall remain operative until further orders.

Registry is directed to register all the interlocutory applications filed in the appeals, special leave petitions or writ petitions. In these interlocutory applications, the grievance which has been canvassed is issue that though they stand on the similar footing with the applicants which have been granted the benefit by the previous order dated 07.12.2015, the State has not considered their cases.

We may make it clear that the cases relating to *Shiksha Mitras* be listed on 11th July 2016 and any interlocutory application connected with *Shiksha Mitras* be also listed along with the cases of *Shiksha Mitras* on that day.

All other cases be listed on 09.05.2016.”

It is submitted that Mr. Satyajeet Kumar, Advocate has on 22.02.2016 filed Applications for impleadment as party petitioner and directions on behalf of Mr. Subodh Kumar and 63 other applicants, but the same is defective as

Applicant No. 1, Mr. Subodh Kumar has already filed applications with same relief and was also registered. However, the said applications have been registered as Interlocutory Application Nos. 6 and 7 of 2016, respectively and are being circulated before the Hon'ble Court.

It is further submitted that Mr. Satyajeet Kumar, Advocate has on 30.03.2016 filed a letter dated 29.03.2016 for withdrawing of Applications for impleadment and directions filed on 04.12.2015 which have been registered as Interlocutory Application Nos. 3 and 4 respectively. (Copy of the letter dated 29.03.2016 is enclosed herewith for the kind perusal of the Hon'ble Court).

The Writ Petition alongwith applications above-mentioned is listed before the Hon'ble Court with this Office Report for Orders.
