O R D E R

Ms. Sucharita, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are aggrieved by only the last part of the impugned order passed by the High Court, wherein the respondents No.1 is directed to be adjusted against the posts remaining vacant since 1996. Counsel for respondent No.1, on the other hand, submits that respondent No.1 is entitled to all the benefits from 1996. Ms. Sucharita will take instructions as to whether the petitioners are agreeable to treat the respondent as if she is in service from 1996 for the purpose of pay fixation and retirement benefits, though without any back-wages.

2. The matter is adjourned for four weeks to enable the counsel for the petitioners to take instructions. That part of the order wherein it has been directed that the respondent will be taken on duty, is to be implemented.
