O R D E R

Prayer for Interim Relief/Bail in CrI.A. No.503/2020

Heard counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the appellants-accused Nos. 5 and 6 (Khakan Rahaman and Mantu Rahaman) are in custody for more than 11 years in reference to the conviction, which is the subject matter of challenge in this appeal, and there is no adverse information about their conduct in jail, coupled with the fact that the co-accused have already been released on bail, we accede to the prayer for grant of bail.

We, accordingly, direct that during the pendency of this appeal, the appellants-accused Nos. 5 and 6 (Khakan Rahaman and Mantu Rahaman) be released on bail in connection with S.T. No.11/2008/Sessions Case No.102/2008 arising out F.I.R. No.140 of 2006 dated 21.12.2006, P.S. Haripal, District Hooghly, West Bengal on such terms and conditions as may be determined by the trial Court, including that the appellants shall

not enter District Hooghly, West Bengal without prior permission of this Court and the appellants shall also intimate their place of stay after release on bail and report to the local police station where they would ordinarily reside once in a month on First Monday of every English Calendar month.
