UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Mr. Maninder Singh, learned Additional Solicitor General submits that according to his instructions the respondents were reinstated on a provisional basis subject to the outcome of present

appeals. He further submits that consequent upon their attaining the age of superannuation the requisite retiral benefits admissible to them have also been ordered to be released in their favour. This position is disputed by learned counsel appearing for the respondents who submits that the respondents have not so far received the retiral benefits.

In the circumstances, therefore, we direct that in case the retiral benefits have not already been released by the appellants the same shall be released expeditiously but not later than six weeks from today. Our order dated 11.05.2012 shall to that extent stand modified. This application is accordingly disposed of. We make it clear that the release of payment of the pensionary benefits shall remain without prejudice to the right of the appellants in the present appeals.
