**OFFICE REPORT**

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court on 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2017, when the following order was passed:-

It is also submitted that Respondent No. 6 was served as per track report of show cause notice issued on 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 but inadvertently Respondent No. 3 was treated as served. Respondent No. 3 is still unserved in the matter. Inconvenience caused is very much regretted. Counsel for the petitioner has already on 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 filed one spare copy of Special Leave Petition.
