OFFICE REPORT

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 13.07.2015, when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

"On a perusal of the Office Report, it transpires that service is not complete.

Learned counsel is permitted to file fresh requisites within a week hence. The Registry shall send them to the concerned Superintendent of Police, who shall effect service on the Respondent No. 2, Dinesh and the respondent No. 6, M.L. Ram, fixing a date for their personal appearance on 7th September, 2015."

It is submitted that in view of aforesaid order, instead of furnishing fresh address, counsel for the petitioner has on 29.07.2015 filed a letter stating address of the Respondents which are given in the petition are only address known to petitioners and to issue summons on same address (Copy of letter dated 28.07.2015 is enclosed herewith). Accordingly Fresh show cause notice to Respondent Nos. 1, 3 to 5 & 7 was issued on 03.08.2015 and Respondent Nos. 2 and 6 through Mr. Gyan Smbandan, DCP North West District, Ashok Vihar, Delhi was sent on 01.08.2015 by special Messenger. Unserved cover received from Respondent Nos. 1, 3 & 5 with postal remarks ' No such person on the

said address'. Neither AD nor unserved cover received from Respondent Nos. 4 & 7.

It is further submitted that DCP, North West District has on 04.09.2015 sent affidavit of service report in respect of Respondent No. 2 Dinesh and Respondent No. 6 i.e. Mr. M.L. Sharma, stating that sincere efforts were made to trace Sh. Dinesh (Respondent No. 2) but no clue of Dinesh was received so far. However a copy of notice and petition has been pasted on the front wall of H. No. C-11, New Cottage Road, Adarsh Nagar Extension, Azadpur, Delhi and in respect of Respondent No. 6 Mr. M.L. Sharma, contempt notice was handed over and receipt obtained (Copy of Affidavit included herewith).

Service is not complete on Respondent Nos. 1 to 5 and 7..

The Contempt Petition in the matter above-mentioned is listed before the Hon'ble Court with this Office Report.
