O R D E R

Pursuant to the order passed by this Court
matter was referred to the Supreme Court Mediation
Centre for an amicable settlement. However, the report
has been received that mediation has failed. Thus,

obviously the matter is to be decided on merits in accordance with law.

Wife has filed this petition under Section 25 of the Civil Procedure Code with the prayer for transfer of M.C. No. 13 of 2011 from K.G.F. Karnataka to Kanpur (U.P.). Having gone through the same, we deem it fit and proper to transfer the matter to the Family Court at Kanpur. The parties are directed to appear before the Family Court, Kanpur, on 29/11/2011 and the Court at K.G.F. Karnataka is directed to remit the record to the said Court forthwith.

The petitioner - wife would file the written statement within fifteen days from the date, she puts

in appearance on 29/11/2011. The Court thereafter would frame the issues and decide the suit itself as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of six months from the date of framing of the issues. It is also expected that none of the parties would seek undue adjournment of the matter.
