**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. After hearing learned counsel appearing for both the parties, we requested Mr. K. Parameshwar, learned senior counsel to assist this Court as *Amicus Curiae* and to give suggestions regarding preparation of the software, indicate in flowchart whereby the cases of the prisoners who have completed the requisite period of sentence in jail after conviction whereafter their cases may be taken for consideration for premature release/remission automatically in terms of policy by virtue of that software. The flow chart would also indicate the period of taking decision stepwise by the authorities which are indulged in this process as per law. It would further indicate the required indulgence of the State Legal Services Authority at appropriate stage and with interval of how many days, the Committee who has to take a decision ought to have sit.
2. Learned *Amicus* is further at liberty to give any additional suggestions which may workout the issues involved.
