The operation of the impugned judgments of the High Court
shall remain stayed until further orders but we are informed that

in one of the matter that is in Civil Appeal No.4008-4009/2014,

since the orders of the High Court have been complied with by

making necessary payments, therefore, we only observe that payment

would be subject to the final result of the appeal.

Having regard to the nature of the issue, its financial implications and having regard to the fact of its peculiar issue, we direct that all these appeals be listed for hearing in the third week of November, 2016 on a Non-Miscellaneous Day.

In view of the fact that we have stayed the operation of the impugned judgments of the High Court in these matters, obviously the respondents would not be able to receive the money which they were found to be eligible by the High Court. Therefore, we deem it appropriate to observe that if in the event the State fails in these appeals, the State would make the payment of the amount due to the respondents under the impugned judgment with some reasonable interest as may be determined by this Court at the time of disposal of these appeals.
