Perused the request of the learned Judge of the Court of Small Causes, C.R. No.13, Mumbai, seeking extension of time by six months for disposing the suit i.e. L.E. & C. Suit No.116/143 of 2008.

Learned counsel representing the plaintiff states that the plaintiff may examine one more witness on its side, while the learned Judge's letter mentions 3-4 witnesses on their side.

Considering the statement now made on behalf of the respondent, we are of the view that the time can be extended by four more months. Accordingly, time is extended by four months ending with April, 2015.
