Our Order dated 26th February, 2010 directing the

status quo to be maintained is clarified as follows:-

The Order of Status Quo granted by us on 26th February, 2010 shall not be applicable to 456 flats already constructed and meant for economically weaker sections of the society. The authorities are free to allot 456 flats meant for economically weaker sections of the society. However, such allotment shall be subject to the final orders to be passed in the matter and parties including the occupants shall not claim any equities. Obviously, the authorities are not entitled to make any constructions whatsoever on the remaining vacant land.
