Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, the averments made in the transfer petition, and in the interest of justice, we allow the transfer petition.

Accordingly, Case no. RCSA/0000132/2022 titled "*Abhishek Singh vs. Nivedita John*", pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, District Court, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh is directed to be transferred to the court of Principal Judge, Family Court at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, who may hear the case himself or assign it to a court of competent jurisdiction.
