O R D E R

Delay in filing the special leave petitions is condoned subject to payment of Rs.2,000/-, as costs, with the Supreme Court Employees' Mutual Welfare Fund, within four weeks from today.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned orders of the High Court. The special leave petitions are dismissed.

However, taking into account the fact that the petitioners were in possession of the lands in question for a long period of time and developed the property, we grant some time to vacate and handover peaceful and vacant possession of the property in question, we deem it appropriate to grant time till 01.10.2016 to the petitioners to vacate and handover peaceful and vacant possession subject to filing of a usual undertaking to that effect in this Court within a period of two weeks from today, making it clear that they will handover peaceful and vacant possession of the property in question free from any encumbrance or third party interest or any other hindrance. Such possession shall be handed over by the petitioners to the respondents on or before 01.10.2016. It is also made clear that all arrears should also be cleared in the meantime.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
