The matter above-mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 17th February, 2017 when the Court was pleased to pass the following Order:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the relevant material.

Leave granted.

In the meantime, no coercive steps shall be taken against the appellant for recovery of arrears of service tax due on or before 30th September, 2011. We clarify that there is no stay of imposition of service tax under sub-clause (zzzz) of clause (105) of Section 65 read with Section 66 of the Finance Act, 1994 (as amended), insofar as the future liability towards service tax with effect from 1st October, 2011 is concerned.

Tag with Civil Appeal No.8878 of 2011.”

It is submitted that Notice of Lodgement of Petition of Appeal was issued to sole respondent on 15.03.2017 through Speed Post. Mr. B. K. Prasad, Advocate has on 05.04.2017 filed Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of sole respondent.

It is further submitted that counsel for the appellant has on 28.04.2017 filed Affidavit of Valuation and Deficit/Ad-Valorem court fee of Rs. 55,000/-. Counsel for respondent has not filed Counter Affidavit so far. Both the parties have not filed Statement of Case so far. Time for filing the same has not yet expired.
