O R D E R

SLP(C) NO.16765-16766/2010

Both respondents in these two matters are the State authorities.

Respondent No.1 is State of U.P. who is yet to be served with the notice. The ld. Counsel for the petitioner to take necessary steps as per modes available under the rules for getting the notice served on respondent No.1.

Respondent No.2 has failed to file counter affidavit within the time granted by the Court.

On behalf of the petitioner, IA Nos. 3-4 have been filed on record requesting for discharge the ld. Advocate, Mr V.N.Raghupathy as they have engaged another ld. Advocate, Mr Shekhar Kumar. By invoking powers under Order VI Rule 17 of the Supreme Court Rules, 1966, application stands allowed and the erstwhile Advocate, Mr V.N.Raghupathy stands discharged.

Necessary steps for getting the notice served on respondent No.1 be taken within a week failing which further necessary orders as per rules shall be passed.
