with interim stay in favour of the petitioner, no steps are taken either to
pay process fee or to confirm service upon respondents. Record shows

that respondent no. 2 has appeared and filed counter affidavit on 19
July, 2010. Though there is no confirmation of service upon him.
However, since counter affidavit is filed his appearance to be recorded as
such through learned advocate Mr. Shekhar Kumar. But the fact remains
that even thereafter respondent nos. 1 and 3 remains unserved, for which
even petitioner has not taken steps till date.

In view of the fact that at present learned counsel Mr. Praveen
Swaroop appeared for the petitioner and they have filed vakalatnama

only on 11 May, 2010; in the interest of justice let there be fresh notice
upon respondent nos. 1 and 3.

Spare copies are to be filed on or before 15 February, 2012,
else list before the Hon'ble Judge in Chamber for non-prosecution.

If it is filed, issue notice with dasti service which is permitted
to be served through the nearest Civil Court/Trial Court, where private
parties are concerned and through standing counsel, where state
authorities are concerned.

List again on 2nd April, 2012.
