In this petition, the petitioner has prayed for transfer of Case No. 210 of 2011 titled Umesh Chandra Gupta v. Neelam Gupta pending before the Family Judge, Haridwar within the State of Uttarakhand.

In response to the query made by the Court, learned counsel stated that so far the issues have not been framed by the Family Court at Haridwar within the State of Uttarakhand.

Issue notice on the transfer petition as also on the petitioner's prayer for interim relief, returnable on 12.07.2013. Dasti, in addition, is permitted.

In the meanwhile, further proceedings in Case No. 210 of 2011 titled Umesh Chandra Gupta v. Neelam Gupta pending before the Family Judge, Haridwar within the State of Uttarakhand shall remain stayed.

It shall be the petitioner's duty to serve the respondent before the next date of hearing failing which the interim order passed today shall stand automatically vacated.
