O R D E R

1. It is seen that since 2019, the petitioner has not taken steps to cure the defects and complying with the rules and procedure of the Court.
2. Indulgently, as prayed for, four weeks' time is granted to the learned counsel for the petitioner to do the needful, subject to deposit of costs of Rs.10,000/- with the Himachal Pradesh Chief Ministers' Relief Fund,
