O R D E R

1. We have heard learned senior counsel at considerable length.
2. We see no ground to interfere with the well-reasoned order dated 19.12.2025 passed by the learned Single Judge of the High Court whereby the order of granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner has been set aside. This is a fit case where the petitioner and all suspects should undergo custodial interrogation to unearth the international racket of drug trafficking.

3. The petitioner is directed to surrender within one week, failing which coercive action shall be taken against him.
