OFFICE REPORT

It is submitted that the above mentioned Special Leave Petition is filed by Mr. Kuldip Singh, Advocate on 24.03.2014 against the Judgment and Order dated 31.10.2012 of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh in CWP No. 21541 of 2012 along with the applications for permission to file additional documents and exemption from filing official translation.

It is further submitted that Counsel for the petitioner has filed two applications for condonation of delay in filing the SLP and refiling the SLP (i) there is a delay of 419 days in filing the SLP (ii) a delay of 16 days in refiling the SLP. There is a total delay of 435 days in filing and refiling the SLP.

It is further submitted that SLP (C) No. 23578 of 2012 arising out of relied upon order was dismissed by Hon'ble Court on 30.07.2012 which is annexed as Annexure P-6 at page nos. 146-148 in the paper books.

It is further submitted that notice in Review Petition NO. 2038 of 2013 in SLP (C) No. 23578 of 2012 Entitled State of Punjab & Ors. Versus Harbans Lal was directed by Hon'ble Court on 31.10.2013. SLP is pending after notice (Copy of order dated 31.10.2013 is annexed as Annexure P- 6 at page no. 146 in the paper books).

The matter is listed before the Hon'ble Court with this office report.
