UPON hearing the counsel, the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Ld. Advocate, Ms. Swati Bansal, appearing on behalf of  
Mr. Rajesh Kumar, Advocate-on-record for respondent No.1  
submits that they could not file the vakalatnama on behalf  
of the substituted respondent Nos.2/1 to 2/3 and would  
require one week's time to do the same.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that since  
service is complete, one final opportunity may be granted to  
them to file their vakalatnama and counter affidavit also.

Upon hearing the Ld. counsels, it is directed that the undertaking of Ld. Advocate, Ms. Swati Bansal to file vakalatnama within one week is accepted and if so filed, time of four weeks thereafter as final opportunity is granted to the said respondents to file their counter affidavits.

Respondent No.1 is granted four weeks' time, as final opportunity, for filing counter affidavit.

Service is complete on respondent No.3, but none has entered appearance on behalf of the said respondent.

At the end of five weeks, whether vakalatnama/counter affidavit are filed or otherwise, the matter be processed for listing before the Hon'ble Court, as per rules.
