OFFICE REPORT

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court on 18.08.2015 when the following order was passed :-

"The served respondents shall be at liberty to file the counter affidavit within a period of four weeks.

Fresh steps for the service of notice by usual mode to the unserved respondent Nos. 4, 29, 31-32, 37 and 48 shall be taken by the learned counsel for the petitioners within a period of four weeks. Dasti in addition is permitted to be served.

List again on 04.11.2015."

It is submitted that there are total 48 respondents. Fresh Show Cause Notice to respondent Nos. 4, 29, 31-32, 37 and 48 was issued by Registered A.D. Post as well as Dasti on 09.10.2015. But neither A.D. Cards nor unserved cover containing notice has been received back. Counsel for the petitioner has not filed affidavit of Dasti so far. Respondent No. 30 is served by Registered A.D. Post but no one has entered appearance on his behalf. Respondent Nos. 1 to 3, 5 to 17 are represented through Ms. Sunita Sharma, Advocate. Respondent Nos. 18-28,

33-36, 38-47 are represented through Mr. Balbir Singh Gupta, Advocate. But both the Advocates have not filed counter affidavits so far.

Service of show cause notice is not complete on respondent Nos. 4, 29, 31-32, 37 and 48.

The matter is listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court with this office report.
