OFFICE REPORT

It is submitted that Mr. Ravindra Bana, Advocate has filed Special Leave Petition on 19.03.2016 against the Judgment and Order dated 22.09.2015 of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh in RFA Nos. 4577/2009, 4580/2009, 4575/2009, 4576/2009, 3168/2009, 3169/2009, 3375/2009, 4578/2009 and 3376/2009 alongwith application for permission to file Special Leave Petition and permission to file additional documents.

It is further submitted that Counsel for petitioner has also filed an application for substitution of deceased petitioner namely Ram Avtar in RFA No. 4578/2009 and Joginder Singh in RFA No. 3376/2009 which is barred by time by 2093 and 126 days respectively and Counsel has

also filed an application for condonation of delay in filing substitution application.

It is further submitted that Counsel for the petitioner has filed two applications for condonation of delay in filing the SLP and refiling the SLP (i) there is a delay of 45 days in RFA Nos. 4575, 3168 & 3169 of 2009 and 48 days in RFA Nos. 4577, 4580, 4576, 3375, 4578 & 3376 of 2009 in filing the SLP (ii) a delay of 12 days in refiling the SLP. There is a total delay of 57 & 60 days in filing and refiling the SLP.

It is further submitted that notice in CC No. 8806/2016 Entitled M/s Chandigarh Bottling Company Versus Union Territory, Chandigarh arising out of common order was directed by the Hon'ble Court on 11.05.2016. SLP is pending after notice (Copy of order dated 11.05.2016 is enclosed herewith).

It is further submitted that notice in SLP (C) No.12986-13007/2016 @ CC No. 7549-7557/2016 Entitled Rajiv Kumar & Anr etc etc Versus Union Territory Chandigarh etc etc arising out of common order was directed by the Hon'ble Court on 29.04.2016. SLP is pending after notice (Copy of order dated 29.04.2016 is enclosed herewith).

It is further submitted that the instant matter is tagged with CC No. 11417/2016 Entitled Jai Kaur & Anr Versus Union Territory, Chandigarh as both are arising out of common order/common relied upon order.

The matter is, therefore, listed before the Hon'ble Court with this office report.
