OFFICE REPORT ON DEFAULT

The matters above mentioned were listed before the Hon'ble Court on 17.08.2012, when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

" Issue notice on the I.As as well as on the special leave petitions."

Accordingly, show cause notice to all the three common respondents was issued through registered A.D. Post on 22.09.2012. Respondent No. 1 is represented through Dr. Vipin Gupta, Advocate and she has also filed Counter Affidavit on his behalf. The name of Respondent No. 3 has already been deleted from the array of parties vide Hon'ble Court (In Chambers) order dated 19.11.2014. Counsel for the petitioner has on 04.12.2014 filed an application for Substitution of deceased Respondent No. 2 which is defective and Counsel has not cured the defects despite Ld. Registrar's orders dated 12.12.2014, 12.02.2015, 23.03.2015, 23.07.2015 and 21.09.2015 and this Registry's letter dated 01.04.2015.

The matters above mentioned were lastly listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court on 10.12.2015, when the following Order was passed:-

" Respondent no.1 has filed counter affidavit. Two counter affidavits have been

filed on his behalf. The ld.Counsel to submit clarification for one of them to be taken on record.

Respondent no.2 is well represented. However, since he has expired, the legal representatives have to be substituted. Though an application for the purpose has already been moved but the defects thereof have not been cured despite the effective opportunities given for the purpose. Though the ld. counsel has requested one more opportunity, but it is apparent through the office report that six earlier adjournment have already been granted.

Let the matter be placed before the Hon'ble Judge in Chambers for further directions."

The office report on default is, therefore, listed before the Hon'ble Court (In Chambers) for orders.
