On hearing learned counsel for the appellant while respondent remained unrepresented, and perusing the record, we are not inclined to the interfere with the concurrent findings of the Rent Controller and the High Court on the issue of eviction of appellant under Section 13-B of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949. We may notice that the appellant has enjoyed the benefit of an interim order for the last 6 years.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed.

At this stage learned counsel for the appellant submits that some time may be given for handing over vacant and peaceful possession. We grant time till 31.12.2022 to the appellant on furnishing usual undertaking to hand over vacant

and peaceful possession and continuing to pay
usual charges.
