O R D E R

We have heard the learned counsels for the parties.

The applicant-appellant is seeking temporary bail, so as to participate in his daughter's marriage (second daughter), which according to the Marriage Card placed on record of this case is scheduled for 28.04.2018.

By order dated 26.02.2016, this Court had granted temporary bail to the applicant-appellant to enable him to arrange and take part in the marriage ceremony of his first daughter.

Keeping in mind the above facts and also that the applicant-appellant has already suffered incarceration for a period of almost eight years, we are of the view that the concession of temporary bail should be extended to the applicant-appellant.

We accordingly direct, that the applicant-appellant shall be released on temporary bail on 21.04.2018, and he shall surrender on 20.06.2018, subject to the following conditions :-

- (i) the applicant-appellant shall furnish two securities in the sum of rupees one lakh each to the satisfaction of the trial Court;
- (ii) the applicant-appellant shall report to the nearest police station twice a week during the period of bail granted to him.

Consequent upon the surrender of the applicant-appellant on 20.06.2018, the jail authorities shall intimate this Court about the factum of his surrender.

Criminal Miscellaneous Petition No. 51949 of 2018 is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.
