O R D E R

1. We have heard Mr. Sunny Chauhan, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. Lokesh Sinhal, the learned AAG appearing for the respondents.

2. Mr. Sinhal invited the attention of this Court to the order of 16th January, 2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench. The order reads:-

“Issue notice.
Notice shall be served by dasti in addition to regular service.
List on 30.01.2023.
Before the next date of hearing, the petitioners in all the matters shall deposit the requisite sum with interest

3. He further pointed out that although the petitioners were not in a position to deposit the requisite amount with interest within the time prescribed, yet the respondents on their own extended the time period and in pursuance of which the petitioners have deposited the entire amount with interest and have been put into possession and the conveyance deed has also been executed.

4. In such circumstances referred to above, nothing is left now to be looked into the matter.
