O R D E R

1. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in 2011 the petitioner had filed a suit for the possession of the property, which belonged to the partnership firm, relying upon the deed of dissolution, however, the said suit was dismissed for default in 2023, and the complaint is now filed by the complainant in 2023, with the allegation that the said dissolution deed is forged one. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the High Court has wrongly recorded that there was a FSL Report, whereas no such report has been ever filed in the criminal case proceedings.
2. In view of the above submissions, let the notice be issued to the respondents, returnable after four weeks.
