OFFICE REPORT

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court on 10.03.2016, when the following Order was passed:-

" Fresh steps for the service of notice by usual mode to the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 shall be taken by the learned counsel for the petitioners within a period of four weeks. Dasti in addition is permitted to be served through the Trial Court the particulars of which shall be furnished by the learned counsel for the petitioners within the period prescribed above.

The Ld. Counsel for the respondent No.4 has failed to file the counter affidavit within the period stipulated under the rules.

List again on 28.4.2016."

It is submitted that there are total four respondents. Service of show cause notice is complete on Respondent No. 1 by registered A.D. Post but no one has filed Vakalatnama & Memo of Appearance on behalf of Respondent No. 1.

It is further submitted that report has been received from Trial Court stating therein that notice has been served on Respondent Nos. 2 & 3. Counsel for the petitioner has also filed affidavit with proof of dasti

service in respect of Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 stating therein that notice have been served on them but no one has filed Vakalatnama & Memo of Appearance on behalf of Respondent Nos. 2 & 3.

It is again submitted that Respondent No. 4 is duly represented through Advocate but no Counter Affidavit has been filed on his behalf.

Service of show cause notice is complete.

The matter is listed before the Id. Registrar's Court with this office report.
