OFFICE REPORT ON DEFAULT

The Transfer Petition above mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 1st July, 2015 when the Court was pleased to pass the following Order:

"Issue notice.

In the meantime, there shall be stay of further proceedings in H.M.A. Petition No. 505/2014 titled as "Vijay Venkatesh Telugu vs. V. Vijayalakshmi" pending in the Court of Ingale Court, CJSJ Pune at Pune until further orders."

Accordingly, notice was issued to the Sole Respondent through Registered A.D. Post on 11th July, 2015.

It is submitted that unserved cover containing the notice has been received from the Sole respondent with the postal remarks "Insufficient Address".

Thereafter, the matter was listed before the Ld. Registrar Court on 17th August, 2015 when he was pleased to pass the following order.

"Ld.counsel for the petitioner shall within a period of four weeks file the fresh particulars of the sole respondent and he shall also take fresh steps for the service of notice to him within the same period. Dasti in addition is permitted to be served.

List the matter again on 03.11.2015.

It is submitted that counsel for the Petitioner has neither filed fresh and complete address of the Respondent nor filed spare copy of Transfer Petition hence notice could not be issued to the Respondent.

Lastly the matter was listed before the Ld. Registrar Court on 20th January, 2016 when he was pleased to pass the following order.

"The office report indicates that although by order dated 3.11.2015 of this Court four weeks time as last chance was given to the Learned Counsel for the petitioner to take fresh steps for the service of notice to the sole respondent, yet he has not done the needful within the period stipulated in the order. Viewed in that context, the matter shall be processed for listing before the Hon'ble Judge in Chambers for further future directions. Await orders. List thereafter."

Service of show cause notice is not complete.

The default on the part of counsel for the Petitioner is reported to Hon'ble Judge in Chamber with this Office Report.
