O R D E R

1. Issue notice on all the respondents.
2. Since the respondent No.1, which is the
contesting respondent, is represented on caveat,
service on the said respondent is dispensed

3. The respondents will be entitled to file
their respective counter affidavits to the
Special Leave Petitions within two weeks;

Division Bench of the High Court, in the Appeal,
