This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of divorce petition bearing O.P. No.748/2018 filed by the respondent-husband in the Family Court at Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh.

At the request of the learned counsel for both sides, the matter was referred to Supreme Court Mediation Centre to explore the possibility of a settlement. However, according to Mediation Report dated 06.09.2019, the attempts in that behalf have not fructified.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties

Considering the facts and circumstances on the record, we deem it appropriate to allow this transfer petition.

Consequently, divorce petition bearing O.P. No.748/2018, titled as "*Deepesh Mishra v. Poonam Mishra*", pending in the Family Court at Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh is transferred to the Family Court at Auriya, Uttar Pradesh.

The Family Court at Jabalpur is directed to transmit the entire record to the transferee court immediately.

The parties are directed to appear before the transferee court on 25.10.2019 at 11 a.m.

We direct the Family Court, Auriya to conclude the proceedings as early as possible and preferably within six months.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this Order to both the Courts for compliance.

This transfer petition is allowed accordingly.
